

BELMONT POLICE DEPARTMENT | Belmont, NH NEW CONSTRUCTION



The H.L. Turner Group Inc. (TTG) was selected by the Town of Belmont to perform architectural and engineering services for the new design of the Belmont Police Department. With a budget of \$3.5 million the project started construction in October of 2020 and finished in October of 2021.

The new 8,500 square foot police headquarters was built adjacent to the previous police station which remained in use during construction. The energy efficient envelope holds a 3 bay garage; one bay with locking metal screen

for vehicle evidence and separate 2 bay sally port; armory, evidence locker with separate weapons evidence room and evidence prep area, cells, interview rooms, observations room, fingerprinting area, secure vestibule, lobby, dispatch, proper offices, conference room, locker rooms, a break room, a mechanical room and storage areas. There is also an ADA limited-use, limited-application elevator, ADA compliant entry, and a radiant heating system. A portion of the original building was saved to be used as storage.
