Energy Efficiency

The Allenstown K-8 Community School sets a high standard for energy efficiency with smart design choices like a displacement air system with dehumidification, cutting energy use by reducing reliance on traditional air conditioning. Solar panels supply about 70% of the school's electricity needs, and insulation levels go far beyond code requirements. Together, these measures save energy and reduce emissions, making the school both cost-effective and environmentally friendly.

Community Impact

This new school is much more than a place to learn - it's a gathering place for the entire Allenstown community. Thoughtfully designed with input from local residents, it provides spaces for learning, recreation, and wellness. Whether hosting student performances or community events, the school has become a source of pride and connection for Allenstown.
